Activity started at 1000z Friday, December 24th until 1000z Sunday, December 26th. We were on the air with two complete stations on CW/SSB 80-10 meters. We made total of 4700 QSO's.

Also known as es-Sebbeh, Horvot Mezada, Mesada, Mezada, Sebbeh, The Stronghold Hebrew Horvot Mezada ("Ruins of Masada"), ancient mountaintop fortress in southeastern Israel, site of the Jews' last stand against the Romans after the fall of Jerusalem in AD 70. Masada occupies the entire top of an isolated mesa near the southwest coast of the Dead Sea. The rhomboid-shaped mountain towers 1,424 feet (434 m) above the level of the Dead Sea. It has a summit area of about 18 acres (7 hectares).
